


Non-Fiction Organizer:



This organizer is great when reading any non-fiction resources (e.g. "Weekly Reader" or "Scholastic News")

As students read their article, they can use this graphic organizer to comprehend or summarize their reading.

How to Use Organizer:

Topic: Write the title of the article or main idea.

Vocabulary: Write any bold words and their definitions. This can also be for any new words the students might learn.

Facts: Write the facts learned in the article. Use bullets for note taking practices.

Questions: Write some questions about the article. This can be comprehension questions or more questions the students might still have.


Opinions: Write thoughts and feelings about the article. Students should be able to write at least one reason why they feel that way about their opinion.




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
